

Tax Credit for Student Bus Passes

Tax Year 2016

Federal tax legislation effective July 1, 2006 allow individuals to claim a nonrefundable tax credit to cover the cost of public transit passes. Full-Time post- secondary students registered between January 1 2016 & December 31, 2016, are eligible to claim the tax credit on the schedule below.

As the Fleming Transportation Program began in September 2016, only Sept. – Dec. 2016 can be claimed for the 2016 tax year.

If You Attended Fleming College Sutherland Campus:	Amount you can claim:	Period that can be claimed:
2016 Fall	\$121.67	September 2016 to December 2016 (The remainder of the fee paid can be claimed for the 2017 tax year)

You are not required to submit documentation when you file your taxes, but would need documentation if your file is reviewed.

Documentation can include:

- A photocopy of your student card
- A copy of your Fleming account statement, along with a list of the ancillary fees paid (flemingcollege.ca/tuition)

The amount paid for the bus pass is not included on the T2202A Form as transportation costs are not eligible to be claimed as tuition.

Note: ***We are unable to issue separate receipts for the transit pass amounts paid.***
