

Fleming SAC [\$50 A Week For A Year – September 2017] CONTEST ("CONTEST")

THIS CONTEST IS OPEN TO Full Time Fleming College Sutherland Campus Students registered for the Fall 2017 and Winter 2018 Semesters

OFFICIAL RULES & REGULATIONS:

By participating in this Contest, each entrant agrees to be legally bound by these Official Contest Rules and Regulations (the "**Rules**").

1. CONTEST PERIOD:

The Contest begins on Sept. 5th, 2017 at 9:00 A.M. Eastern Time (ET) and ends on September 22nd, 2017 at 12:00 PM. (the "**Contest Period**").

2. ELIGIBILITY:

The Contest is open to **Full Time Fleming College Sutherland Campus Students registered for the Fall 2017 and Winter 2018 Semesters** except college employees, Staff & representatives of Student Administrative Council or any other vendors working with or for S.A.C (and those with whom such persons are domiciled). Students must be full time, active students at the time of the draw. If a student withdraws from Fleming College a secondary draw will be made & the prize will go to another eligible student.

3. HOW TO ENTER:

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY. You may enter the Contest at every event that ballots are provided.

By submitting a ballot, you qualify for the \$50 a week draw as long as eligibility is met. Ballot entries have no limit. They will be distributed during all student events through out the contest period. Ballots must be received within the Contest Period in compliance with the Rules (as determined by the Student Administrative Council in its sole and absolute discretion).

4. ENTRY LIMITS:

There are no limits to the number of entries per eligible person during the Contest Period. All eligible students will have access to ballots at campus events where they are provided. If it is discovered by the Sponsor (using any evidence or other information made available to or otherwise discovered by the Sponsor) that any person has attempted to: (i) Submit unofficial ballots; and/or (ii) use multiple names, identities, email addresses to enter or otherwise participate in or to disrupt this Contest; then he/she may be disqualified from the Contest in the sole and absolute discretion of Student Administrative Council. Your Entry may be rejected if (in the sole and absolute discretion of the Sponsor) it is not submitted and received in accordance with these Rules during the Contest Period. The Released Parties (defined below) are not responsible for late, lost, misdirected, delayed, incomplete, illegible or incompatible Entries (all of which are void).

All Entries and entrants are subject to verification at any time and for any reason. S.A.C reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to require proof of identity and/or eligibility (in a form acceptable to the Student Administrative Council – including, without limitation, government issued photo identification): (i) for the purposes of verifying an individual's eligibility to participate in this Contest; (ii) for the purposes of verifying the eligibility and/or legitimacy of any entry or other information submitted (or purportedly submitted) for the purposes of this Contest; and/or (iii) for any other reason the S.A.C deems necessary, in its sole and absolute discretion, for the purposes of administering this Contest in accordance with these Rules. Failure to provide such proof to the complete satisfaction of the S.A.C within the timeline specified by S.A.C may result in disqualification.

5. SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS:

BY SUBMITTING AN ENTRY, YOU AGREE THAT THE ENTRY (AND EACH AFTER THE INITIAL BALLOT) COMPLIES WITH ALL CONDITIONS STATED IN THESE RULES. THE RELEASED PARTIES (DEFINED BELOW) WILL BEAR NO LEGAL LIABILITY REGARDING THE USE OF YOUR ENTRY (OR ANY COMPONENT THEREOF) BY THE CONTEST PARTIES. THE RELEASED PARTIES (DEFINED BELOW) SHALL BE HELD HARMLESS BY YOU IN THE EVENT IT IS SUBSEQUENTLY DISCOVERED THAT YOU HAVE DEPARTED FROM OR NOT FULLY COMPLIED WITH ANY OF THESE RULES.

To be eligible for entry in this Contest, you must use the official ballots handed out at student events, the information provided

By participating in the Contest, each entrant agrees to be legally bound by these Rules and by the interpretation of these set by the Student Administrative Council, and further.

The Staff at the Student Administrative Council will verify ballot entries for eligibility (5) business days of its receipt. Any entry that the SAC deems to be fraudulent or no longer valid will be disposed of. By submitting a ballot, you agree that your entries are true to eligibility. You agree S.A.C is free to disclose the identity of you as the winner to anyone upon winning the \$50 a week draw. By entering the Contest and submitting a Reply, each entrant (i) grants the Sponsor, in perpetuity, an exclusive license to use publish, display, use his/her identity in whole or in part, in any way, including, without limitation, for the purpose of advertising or promoting the draws success and the services or products of Student Administrative Council. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the Sponsor is in no way obligated to use, implement, publish or broadcast any winner, and any use shall be in the Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion.

6. PRIZE AND APPROXIMATE VALUE:

There will be one (1) grand prize (the "**Grand Prize**") available to be won, which consists of \$50 CAD per week beginning September 5th, 2017 ending April 20th, 2018. The funds will be awarded in the form of direct deposit, considering the draw is post start date of the weekly payments the winner will be granted a back dated cheque for the amount owing. This can be picked up at the SAC office after declaring the winner & they are notified.

The \$50 a week runs for the Fall 2017 semester (September 5th 2017 – December 15th 2017) & Winter 2018 Semester (January 8th 2018 – April 20th 2018). \$50 will be deposited on agreed date between S.A.C & the winner. The total approximate value of the prize is \$1500.

The Grand Prize will be referred to as the "**Prize**". The Prize must be accepted as awarded and is not transferable, assignable or extendable. No substitutions except at Sponsor's option. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to substitute any Prize with a prize of equal or greater retail value, including, without limitation, but at Sponsor's sole and absolute discretion, an alternative award. Any alternate prize is subject to the terms and conditions of the issuer.

7. GRAND PRIZE WINNER SELECTION PROCESS:

Throughout the Contest Period, ballots will be distributed & collected during student events on campus. Representatives of the Student Administrative Council will collect & distribute said ballots. Staff of the S.A.C with absolute discretion & confidentiality will verify ballots for eligibility.

On the morning of September 22nd, 2017 (the "**Draw Date**"), a winner will be selected via random draw within the Student Administrative Council office by a Staff member. At this time the winner will be verified for eligibility. If student is no longer eligible another draw will be made & again verification process will take place.

The Student Administrative Council or designated representative will contact the winner by email or telephone (using the information associated with his/her ballot) within 48 hours of the draw the selection date. If the potential Grand Prize winner cannot be contacted within a maximum of 2 weeks another draw will be made. Selection Date or there is a return of any notification as undeliverable; then he/she will be disqualified (and will forfeit all rights to the Grand Prize) and S.A.C reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to re-draw for another entry who submitted a ballot.

9. GENERAL CONDITIONS:

ANYONE DEEMED BY THE STUDENT ADMINISTRATIVE COUNCIL TO BE IN VIOLATION OF THESE RULES FOR ANY REASON IS SUBJECT TO DISQUALIFICATION IN THE SOLE AND ABSOLUTE DISCRETION OF THE S.A.C AT ANY TIME.

In the event of a dispute regarding who submitted an Entry, Entries will be deemed to have been submitted by the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the Account that was used to submit the Entry in question. "Authorized account holder" is defined as the person who is assigned an email address by an internet provider, online service provider, or other organization (e.g. business, educational institute, etc.) that is responsible for assigning email addresses for the domain associated with the submitted email address. An entrant may be required to provide proof that he/she is the authorized account holder of the email address associated with the Account that was used to submit the Entry in question and, if applicable, that he/she has all necessary consents, permissions and/or licenses as required by these Rules.

The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to withdraw, suspend or amend this Contest (or to amend these Rules) in any way, in the event of an error, technical problem, computer virus, bugs, tampering, unauthorized intervention, fraud, technical failure or any other cause beyond the reasonable control of the Sponsor that interferes with the proper conduct of this Contest as contemplated by these Rules. Any attempt to deliberately damage any website or to undermine the legitimate operation of this Contest is a violation of criminal and civil laws and should such an attempt be made, the Sponsor reserves the right to seek remedies and damages to the fullest extent permitted by law. The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to cancel, amend or suspend this Contest, or to amend these Rules, without prior notice or obligation, in the event of any accident, printing, administrative, or other error or any kind, or for any other reason. Without limiting the generality of the forgoing, the Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, to administer an alternate test of skill as it deems appropriate based on the circumstances and/or to comply with applicable law.

This Contest is subject to all applicable federal, provincial and municipal laws. The decisions of the Student Administrative Council with respect to all aspects of this Contest are final and binding on all entrants without right of appeal, including, without limitation, any decisions regarding the eligibility/disqualification of entrants and Entries.

The Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole and absolute discretion, and without prior notice, to adjust any of the dates and/or timeframes stipulated in these Rules, to the extent necessary, for purposes of verifying compliance by any entrant or Entry with these Rules, or as a result of technical problems, or in light of any other circumstances which, in the opinion of the Sponsor, in its sole and absolute discretion, affect the proper administration of the Contest as contemplated in these Rules.

By entering this Contest, each entrant expressly consents to the Student Administrative Council its agents and/or representatives, storing, sharing and using the personal information submitted with his/her ballot for the purpose of administering the Contest and in accordance with S.A.Cs privacy policy (available at This section does not limit any other consent(s) that an individual may provide the Sponsor or others in relation to the collection, use and/or disclosure of their personal information.

In the event of any discrepancy or inconsistency between the terms and conditions of these Rules and disclosures or other statements contained in any Contest-related materials, the terms and conditions of these Rules shall prevail, govern and control.
